## **VALLARAPU EARNS KUDOS FROM NATIONAL COMMISSION**

Florida Skin Center's Shirisha Vallarapu, a board-certified physician assistant (PA), has been selected by the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA) as one of 50 PAs in the U.S. who are making a difference in healthcare. The only national not-for-profit of its kind chose her out of 250-plus nominees. She is expected to be featured on PAsDoThat.com, a website partly dedicated to marking the 50th anniversary of the PA profession, in mid-July. Vallarapu participates in free skin check and skin disease fundraising events, such as the upcoming Take Your Skin to a Better Place 5k for Melanoma, initiated by the practice, as well as speaking engagements at schools, work facilities and community group locations. A graduate of Miami University in Ohio and Nova Southeastern University in Fort Lauderdale, Vallarapu was awarded Diplomate status from the Society of Dermatology Physician Assistants. She has extensive training in laser hair removal and vascular treatments, as well as dermal filler and BOTOX Cosmetic injections.
